1. **SUBJECT: Greek Week 2013**

DETAIL: Greek Week is next week! The theme this year is "Around the World". Every chapter will be representing the country they have chosen throughout the entire week. We encourage everyone to come join us! We will have fun philanthropic events from May 6 through May 18.

Greek Week Event Break-Down

- **Monday, 6**
 - **Quiz Bowl:** This event will take place at 5:30 in Ursa Major. This is a competition based on common everyday knowledge. Each chapter has a panel of representatives that compete to show that they have the brains. Chapter members are required to bring a children's book to the Greek Life Office between 3:00 and 5:00 pm.
- **Tuesday, 7**
 - **Can Day:** This event is set to take place during U-Hour in the University Quad. The individual chapters will build a can structure using no more than 700 cans and no less than 500 cans. The structure will be somehow representative of the country that each chapter has chosen to represent. They will also be performing a skit around their structure. All of the cans will then be donated.
- **Wednesday, 8**
 - **Olympics:** This event will take place at 6:00 pm in the Soccer Fields. It is a competition of a series of athletic events between sororities and fraternities. The events include a relay race and a tug of war competition. Every chapter member is required to bring a toiletry item to the Greek Life Office between 3:00 and 5:00 pm.

- **Thursday, 9**
 - **Food Fair:** This event will take place during U-Hour in the University Quad. Each chapter will be selling a food item that pertains to their country. Their goal is to sell as much as possible and raise the most funds.
- **Friday, 10**
 - **Lip Sync:** This event will take place at 7:00 pm in the Bronco Commons. Chapters have compiled a mixture of music and voice audio to make a skit that is about eight minutes long. There is a charge of five dollars to enter this event. Chapter members are required to bring a new clothing article to the Greek Life Office between 4:00 and 6:00 pm.
- **Tuesday, 14**
 - **Profit Share:** This is an all-day event at California Pizza Kitchen in Chino Hills. Chapter members have been given swipe cards that take 20% of their bill. That money is then given to Greek Council.
- **Wednesday, 15**
 - **Blood Drive:** The Greek Community will be working with the Red Cross in an effort to donate much needed blood. This event will take place in the BSC.
- **Saturday, 18**
 - **Relay for Life:** The Greek Community will be participating in the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life. We will be fundraising and raising awareness for cancer victims.
