1. SUBJECT: BRIC

DETAIL:

- ASI is ready for over 800 students to attend the three days of the BRIC Job Fair
- Dozens of ASI student leaders and staff have volunteered to ensure the BRIC Job Fair is a success
- Please join us in welcoming:
 - Ginny Templeton, from Brown University, will join the team as the Operations Manager
 - Kaycee Tanioka, from the University of New Hampshire, will lead Campus Recreation's legacy program, Intramural Sports
- Unfortunately, the Aquatics Coordinator search did not produce a viable candidate. Plans for a new search will convene in early June
- There are 4 months remaining on the construction timeline for the BRIC
- The BRIC doors will open no later than Thursday, September 25th
- ASI will celebrate the BRIC opening with the students on Friday, September 26th
- Plans for the BRIC Grand Opening are scheduled for Wednesday, October 8th. The Task Team continues to define the elements for what is sure to be a memorable event

2. SUBJECT: Bronco Fitness Center

- The BFC is maintaining just over 1600 active members with 5000 visits this month
