ASI Executive Director's Report

1. SUBJECT: BRIC Job Fair

DETAIL:

- Kudos to our HR and Campus Recreation Teams for the diligent planning and organization efforts prior to the Job Fair. Kudos as well to each and every ASI Team member (students and staff) and volunteer who signed up to provide the needed staffing for all three days. It was truly amazing to see ASI teamwork in action.
- A total of 737 applicants turned out for the three-day BRIC Job Fair.
- All applicants will receive notification as to whether or not they were selected by June 30th.

2. SUBJECT: BRIC Project Timeline

DETAIL:

The project continues to be on schedule and upcoming (tentative) milestones include:

- Climbing Wall completed – June 24th
- Temporary Occupancy – August 1st (begin to receive furniture and equipment)
- Delivery/Installation of Furniture and Equipment – August 4th – August 30th
- Climbing Wall route setting with pro climber Josh Larson – August 4-5th
- Student Team Training – September 3rd – September 21st
- Project (Construction) Completion – September 12th
- “Soft” Opening (adjusted operating hours) – September 22nd – September 24th
- BRIC “Official” Opening (with evening celebration for CPP students) – September 25th
- BRIC’s GRAND OPENING – October 8th

- Through the use of social media, ASI shared the iPad Mini Giveaway

- The launch of the giveaway began Tuesday, May 20th through ASI social media outlets and an all student email from ASI President, Christine Hall
- Handbills with the giveaway information was created for Student Government to distribute on campus and for Gas to distribute at various tabling events
- As of Thursday, May 22nd, the giveaway has accumulated 16,000 entry points which equals almost 4,000 responses...and counting

July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2019

- The term of the Operating Agreement and Lease is July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2019.

- Student Body Organization Programs, which include the operation of a physical fitness/recreation facility, games room, operation of a child day care center, student activities and programs, such as fund raising, public relations and similar development programs by those student clubs assigned to ASI Councils and those that receive ASI funding; and
- Instructionally Related Programs and Activities, including Agriculture, Athletics, Newspaper and other Instructionally Related Programs and Activities
