**ASI Executive Director's Report**

**1. SUBJECT: Welcome 2014-15 ASI Student Leaders**

**DETAIL:**

**2. SUBJECT: BRIC**

**DETAIL:**

- The BRIC is on schedule to open on Thursday, September 25.
- ASI will celebrate the BRIC opening with the students on Friday, September 26 as part of Bronco Fusion.
- Plans for the BRIC Grand Opening are scheduled for Wednesday, October 8. The Planning Team continues to define the elements for what is sure to be a memorable event.
- All full-time and student employees positions, except the Aquatics Coordinator, have been filled.

**3. SUBJECT: Bronco Fitness Center Conversion to Multi-Use Lounge**

**DETAIL:**

The former Bronco Fitness Center area will be converted to a multi-use lounge space. Special attention was made in creating space for group seating with soft seating and table seating. All furniture groupings will have access to power outlets to complement the improvement in the WiFi signal coverage in the BSC.

Construction duration is 52 days, from June 30 – August 20

- ASI move out (June 16 – 27). The Campus Recreation team did a great job in coordinating the removal of all exercise equipment, which allowed the contractor to start on time.

- Contractor on site (June 30 – August 15). Currently, the contractor has removed all wall mirrors from the space and is refinishing those walls. They have also started framing the partition walls in the locker rooms which will be converted to public restrooms.
- New Furniture Installation (September 2 – 12). The project is on schedule to meet this window of time. The installation will most likely be week of September 8 depending on furniture delivery dates.
- Multi-Use Lounge opens – September 22, 2014

#### **4. SUBJECT: ASI's Partnership with Orientation Services**

##### **DETAIL:**

Every summer, ASI hires a special team of students to be the face of ASI to the incoming freshmen and transfers. This summer CPP is expecting 6,200 new students to pass through the Bronco Student Center during the orientation sessions and ASI's Fab 5 team will share what our organization is all about. The Fab 5 are: Demont Oliver (Campus Recreation), Snah Desai (Gas), Amanda Villar (Gas), AJ Iroko (Campus Recreation), and Lay Xin (Games Room).

ASI takes over the Andromeda Suite during the weekly club fairs, which is the first point of contact for the new students. Later in the day, the Fab 5 provide a 20 minute live presentation that includes photos and video of our buildings, services, programs and how to be involved with ASI.
