The updated version includes the added project scope not to exceed \$350,000 as approved by the ASI Senate at the last meeting. It also incorporates an adjustment for enrollment and student fee revenue for those students enrolled prior to Fall 2010 who may opt in to pay the fee in order to access and use the facility.

Kudos to Barny, Cathy, RPM and Facilities staff for the behind the scenes planning and work to put on this event.
