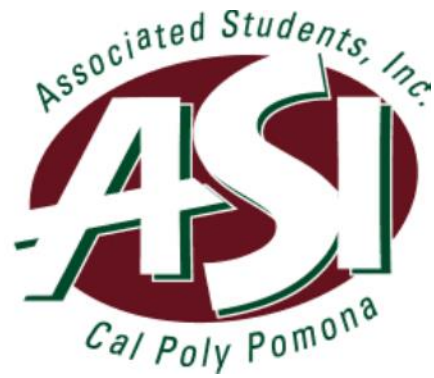
### **Position Updates:**
