ASI Executive Director's Report

1. SUBJECT: Campus Recreation – Aquatics Coordinator

DETAIL

- Jessica Barragan has accepted the temporary, professional staff appointment as the Assistant Coordinator for Aquatics. Jessica has over six years of part-time and full-time (seasonal) experience working in the field of aquatics. Currently, she holds the position of Aquatics Supervisor directly supporting Ginny Templeton to oversee the BRIC Pool facility operations, related staff, programming and special events. Over the last 10 months in this role, Jessica's accomplishments include creating an emergency action plan for the pool and main building, establishing standard operating procedures for the aquatics program, facilitating multiple in-service trainings for a team of 24 lifeguards and 6 instructors, and successfully initiating almost 10 new programs (workshops, clinics, and certification courses) as well as special events with attendance rates of more than 400 students. Jessica's appointment begins on June 22nd for a term of one year.

2. SUBJECT: Hibachi San

DETAIL

- Last Friday, the Facilities and Operations Committee received an update regarding the opening of Hibachi San in Center Court of the BSC. The project was awaiting plan approval by the Fire Marshall for the past several weeks, which is the final requirement before the venue can test their equipment and prepare for opening. The Fire Marshall had some comments and questions on the final plans and asked that the issues be addressed and the plans returned for a final review. This will delay the opening of Hibachi San and as the final approval is based on the Fire Marshall's availability, there is no set date for the venue to open.

3. SUBJECT: BSC Projects

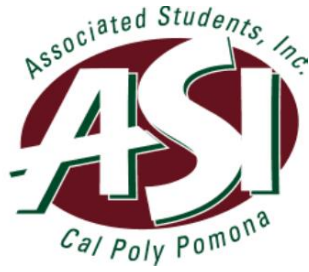
2. **Subject: Science Council End of the Year**
