ASI Executive Director's Report

1. SUBJECT: BRIC Builders Award

DETAIL:

- The BRIC received the **2015 Award of Merit for Best Sustainable Commercial Project** from the PCBC. According to their website, PCBC's Gold Nugget Awards are the oldest and most prestigious design awards in the nation recognizing those who improve our communities through exceptional concepts in design, planning and development. The plaque will reside at the BRIC.

2. SUBJECT: Refunding of BSC Series 2005 A Outstanding Bond Debt

DETAIL:

- The CSU Chancellor's Office confirmed that the above outstanding bond debt on the expansion of the BSC has been refunded (or refinanced) to take advantage of favorable market conditions. This resulted in a net present value savings of \$2,767,855.

3. SUBJECT: Update on Bronco Copy and Mail Equipment

DETAIL:

- Our insurance coverage will cover up to \$45,152 of the damage to the printer and copier in Bronco Copy N' Mail as a result of the flooding from the air handler system malfunction on August 3, 2015.
- The quote for replacing both equipment is \$62,705. Thus, ASI will be responsible for the difference of nearly \$18,000. This will be covered through the BSC Operating Reserve in the approved BSC Budget for 2015-16.
