3. SUBJECT: ASI Financial Services Updates

DETAIL:

Independent Audit

Our auditor will be on site from May 23rd – May 25th to conduct pre-closing audit. The audit firm VLS will be undergoing a merger with CliftonLarsonAllen, or CLA, and effective this July, their name will change to CLA.

Automatic Payments

Starting May 1st, Financial Services will be implementing Automatic Payments for payments due to Foundation. Student clubs, organizations and departments will be required to take out purchase orders (using the new PO form) before placing orders with the Foundation. Foundation will send out invoices to authorized signers and payments will be automatically deducted from the accounts. More information will be sent out by email in the near future.

4. SUBJECT: Campus Recreation Updates

DETAIL:

The week of April 17th through April 23rd the BRIC had an average of 3,115 check-ins per day (Monday through Thursday) and 1,332 check-ins per day (Friday through Sunday). There is a 27% increase of check-ins from this time last year. As of April 24th there are 18,249 student members which is 79.03% of the fee assessed student population (23,090). This is an increase of 11.72% of student members compared to this time last year (16,334).
