





SB 2016-17:04

ASI Inter-Council Committee Code

- I. Purpose: The Inter-Council Committee shall act to promote and foster collaboration among the ASI councils, the student organizations under them, and ASI. The committee shall exchange information about council, student organization(s), and ASI events, leadership opportunities, programs, and any relevant student issues in an effort to unify the campus. Furthermore, the committee shall facilitate and encourage student engagement by advocating for student interest.
- II. Composition: The Inter-Council Committee shall include:
- A. Chair:
 - i. The Secretary of Internal Affairs
 - B. Voting Members:
 - i. The ASI Council Presidents, or their Council Executive Board designee.
 - C. Liaisons:
 - i. The ASI Attorney General
 - ii. An ASI B.E.A.T. representative
 - iii. The ASI Executive Director or designee
 - iv. One (1) University Advisor
- III. Duties of the Committee Chair: The Committee Chair shall be responsible for the duties listed in the ASI By-Laws, such as: properly and efficiently carrying out the business of the committee, posting the agenda, preparing minutes, and reporting regularly to the Cabinet collaborative efforts by the committee.
- IV. Meetings: Meetings shall be held a minimum of once a term and as necessary. Meetings shall be called by the Chair or by two-thirds (2/3) of the voting members of the Committee. The agenda must be posted 72 hours (3 business days) in advance to comply with the Gloria Romero Open Meeting Act, or if replaced, its successor act.

- V. Quorum: Quorum is established when majority of voting members are present. Quorum is defined as a majority of seated voting members.
- VI. Voting Procedures: Decisions shall be made when a simple majority is in agreement.
- VII. Amendments: Any amendments to this code shall be reviewed by the Rules and Policies Committee and approved by the ASI Senate with a two-thirds (2/3) vote.
