4. SUBJECT: Campus Recreation Updates

DETAIL:

FACILITIES: The week of April 3rd, the BRIC recorded an average of 3,677 check-ins per day (Monday through Thursday) and 1062 check-ins per day Friday through Sunday. This is a 29.3% increase of check-ins from this time last year. As of April 10th, there are 18,171 student members which is 78.76% of the fee assessed student population. This is an increase of 11.51% of student members (16,296) compared to this time last year.

NEW PROGRAMS: On Tuesday April 11th, Campus Recreation launched a 5 week instructional clinic called "Big Wall Climbing". The clinic is \$30 addresses the basic techniques required to climb on big wall terrain. Participants will learn the basic necessary skills and learn how to plan and execute a big wall climb.

CLASSES: The Intro to Boxing instructional clinic began on April 11th and will continue for 8 weeks, meeting twice a week for 55 minutes. This instructional clinic is \$30 for BRIC members. In Studio B, the clinic is taught in a progressive format where participants will learn the basics of kicks, punches, and movement patterns utilizing heavy bags and small equipment focusing on improving core conditioning and functional strength.

WORKSHOPS: Thursday, April 13th is the first Kettlebell Training workshop for Spring 2017. This workshop is 12-1pm on the second floor of the BRIC for \$5. Each workshop covers basic kettlebell form and technique, resistance style exercises, cardiovascular style exercises, and high intensity style exercises. The workshop will run two additional dates with each session teaching a different skill.

TRIPS: This Saturday, April 15th, join Campus Recreation Adventure Instructors for Paddle, Yoga & Picnic at Bonelli Park. This day trip will include yoga and kayak instruction at Lake Bonelli for \$45. The morning will begin by performing yoga, then they will transition into paddling across the lake and stopping to have a picnic at a cove. The day will finish by completing the loop and returning to campus. Transportation, equipment and lunch are included.

LEAGUES: Deadline to register a team for one of the Spring 2017 intramural sports leagues is this Thursday, April 13th at 5pm. Individual players can join a registered team until May 19th. Spring sports include 7v7 Soccer, Basketball, Flag Football and Softball. The quarter Intramural Sports All Access Pass is \$15.00.
