Presented by Jane and Carlos from Students for a Sustainable Future Requesting \$2,929.24

Question by Treasurer: budget breakdown. How do you plan on maintenance? In TGIF, you can't request for maintenance.

A: Collaboration with Housing will help us promote our maintenance. Opportunities for donations with Dr. Fox too.

Question by Science: For the students that would oversee the garden, is that a selected group, part of a class?

A: They will be following a volunteer-based qualification. Plan is to have the club members that join the Community Garden Committee. They will have a constitution that outlines the rules and procedures there. The E-board will be overseeing all of this.

Question by Treasurer: What was the conversation with facilities? A: It began with email last semester with Bryan from Facilities Planning and Management, with the Office of Sustainability and Dr. Fox. They approved the project if there are procedures for clean-up.

Question by Engineering: How many students will it service? A: At CSUN, they have had a community garden for 10 years. We don't have exact numbers, but within a week, we had 30 students submit an interest form.

Advisor: In the future, consider IRA funding as it would be a good source to get consistent funding support from there.
